

SDMA Senior Blood Test Success

Thanks to the brand new SDMA blood test, our recent 6 monthly senior programme detected 7 pets in kidney failure who appeared healthy and had normal standard kidney blood tests.

They have been placed on special kidney failure diets to prolong their life and slow down the spiralling kidney disease process.

During the senior programme, we also detected 2 dogs with Cushing's disease and 4 with urinary tract infections; all now receiving therapy. Quite a number of pets had teeth and gums that needed attention, and a few suspicious lumps were removed.

Our regular patients over 7 years of age all receive a free senior check and nail clip every 6 months to make sure they stay in top shape. Prevention is so much better than cure.

Symptoms of Tick Paralysis

Sick pets can start off with vague symptoms that gradually worsen over a short time...

- Slightly slow getting up from a rest
- A light huffy "exhaling" sort of cough
- Cats sometimes make a terrible howling/crying out sound like they are being throttled
- Some pets will have a sore area where the tick is attached, so check it out thoroughly
- Ticks can cause local paralysis also. If on the side of the head, the eye on that side may not be able to blink and/or the lip may be drooping.

Note: The tick anti serum works very well in these early cases, but much less so the worse the symptoms become. Start calling BHVG on (02) 4448 5621 now (24 Hours Emergency)

With further delay...

- Weakness in all 4 legs
- Difficulty in breathing with marked effort involved
- Collapse
- Excessive drooling
- Vomiting
- Blue gums (cyanosis)
- Death

In Sydney, some of these serious cases end up on a ventilator and 24-hour emergency care, and quickly run up bills up to and over \$10,000 with no guarantee of success.

Tick Searching

Hopefully, your long-haired pet is no longer long-haired i.e. it's already been clipped in early spring.

Start with Marks Finger Tap Trick

If the tick is on one side of the head, the eye on the same side is often paralysed and can't blink. This is the first thing I check for in a suspect tick case. Do a light finger tap close to the outside

Worming Reminder

Is it time for your pet's 3 monthly intestinal wormer? Worming is very important as some products do not protect against all intestinal worms. Please check and see which medication your pet is on or ask us for advice on which product is best suited to you and your pet.

edge of each eye to check the eyelids can blink. If there is no blink, there is a very high chance the tick is on the same side of the head, so start looking.

Tick Searching the Body

90% of ticks are from the shoulders forward where pets can't bite and remove the tick when they first feel it on their skin. Having said that, other areas to thoroughly check are...

- The bottom and genitals (you know, those areas you don't really want to check)
- High up in between the toes where your finger can't go
- Tail (even the very tip)
- Ear flaps and ear canals a favourite spot for ticks

Position yourself in front of your pet & run your fingers against the fur i.e. from tail towards the head using both hands. Do one section of the body at a time e.g. right side of the neck, top of the neck, left side of neck etc. Straighten out the neck when finger searching as loose skin folds make it hard to feel a tick- it may be easier to lay the pet on its side and have another person stretch out the head so the skin on the neck is nice and tight.

When you Find a Tick

Don't apply metho or other chemicals on it as they aggravate the tick before it dies making it release more poison. Use a Tick Remover (available at BHVG) or a fine pair of forceps. Place the remover as low down as possible to the skin below the tick before giving a quick twisting pull to remove it. Don't worry if you leave the head behind- the tick is dead and is not going to inject more poison.

Is that it once I have pulled out the tick?

No! If the tick has already injected some toxin into the skin e.g. in the last hour, pulling it out does not stop the toxin going on its way around the body. You must keep an eye out for early symptoms for up to 2-3 days as this is how long it can take for the toxin to work. Also remember that if you found one tick, there is a high chance there is another one (or even more) on the body so keep searching.

When to Come to the Vet

The tick anti-serum only works in the first few hours of symptoms starting. The actual antibodies in the serum are really good at destroying tick toxin in the blood stream, but are too big to "seek and destroy" the toxin once it leaves the blood and travels down nerves to paralyse muscles.

First Snake Bite of the Season

M ark had to treat Jack (an inquisitive cocker spaniel) last weekend who had been bitten by a very large black snake. Luckily, the owners phoned ahead, allowing Mark time to setup the IV drip and anti-venom while they were on their way.

The side of his face was very swollen and painful, and he was very weak and had distressed breathing.

There were 2 large puncture wounds on the side of his neck (see photo). He was given snake anti-venom and



placed on a drip and oxygen overnight. By the next morning, he was barking and looking much better and went home on Monday full of beans.

Make sure your yards contain no rubbish that snakes can hide under. If bitten, make sure you phone ahead to save precious minutes.

How to Avoid Buying a Dud Dog from a Puppy Farm



If you have your sights set on a pedigree dog, here's a few tips to ensure you don't run into trouble.

- 1) The breeder will be happy for you to visit the establishment. Absolutely no ordering of pups online with delivery to remote addresses. It's very easy to disguise a puppy farm with a spruced-up webpage, and you will be discouraged from visiting.
- 2) There will be nice clean kennels and surrounds with all dogs (including the parents) being in good shape with plenty of room to run around. Certainly, no caged animals.
- 3) The pup will have had a vet check-up, first vaccines, microchip (compulsory) and have been wormed.
- 4) The microchip details would be transferred to the new owners by the breeder at point of purchase.
- 5) The breeder would give you copies of the parents' hip and elbow x-ray scores to minimise the chance of hip or elbow dysplasia in your new pup.
- 6) If extra good, the breeder will also give you the results of DNA scans on both parents to rule out certain hereditary conditions for that breed e.g. eye disease, haemophilia.
- 7) The breeder will be recommending a high-quality puppy dry food and no supplements and no raw chicken.
- 8) There would be no talk of hip or elbow dysplasia being caused by incorrect diets and the puppy "growing too fast", especially if the breeder has not given you copies of the parent's hip and elbow scores. Walk away ASAP if you hear any of this nonsense.



Phone Ahead & Save Precious Minutes!

If you have an emergency e.g. snake bite, tick bite, hit by car, CALL BHVG on (02) 448 5621 FIRST before travelling to ensure a vet is available and we can start organising drugs, IV drips, oxygen etc. before you get here. This is very important for snake and tick bites. Every minute counts!

Appointment System

Both our Berry and Shoalhaven Heads clinics work on an appointment system. This helps you avoid long queues and allows vets time to do house calls, perform long operations or even duck out to get a bite of lunch.

When it's time to euthanise a pet, we like to have an empty waiting room for our upset clients. To avoid disappointment and distress, please phone ahead and make an appointment.

Emergencies take priority over any routine procedures, but call ahead of you are on your way.
