Option 1	IV drip & blood pressure monitoring	Cost \$75.00	Yes	No
<p>One of the side effects of all anaesthetics is lowering of blood pressure (BP). In some patients, it drops too low and vital organs such as the liver; kidneys and brain are deprived of vital oxygen. This can have serious consequences e.g. anaesthetic complications or kidney failure. By monitoring blood pressure and giving intravenous fluids (an IV drip), we can quickly detect and correct any problems.</p>

<p>Pre-anaesthetic blood tests are very important to ensure a pet's health. They check major body organs, red blood cells and blood clotting.  <i>For more comprehensive testing for older or sick pets; please ask one of our staff.</i></p>
